Define the business problem AI will solve, quantify the opportunity, and connect it to strategic priorities. Avoid jargon; speak in financial and operational terms the board understands.

Slide 2 – The Strategic Roadmap

Outline the Al journey in phases: quick wins, mid-term milestones, and long-term transformation. Include governance checkpoints to show you've considered risks and compliance.

Slide 3 – The Impact Forecast

Show expected ROI, risk mitigation, and competitive positioning. Include measurable KPIs that can be tracked over time.

Leadership Takeaway

A board-level Al briefing must inspire confidence and demonstrate strategic alignment. Three slides force clarity, focus, and discipline—qualities boards value when making high-impact decisions.

Case Study: Al for Predictive Maintenance in Aerospace

A leading aerospace manufacturer faced rising maintenance costs and downtime. The Al pitch to the board focused on predictive maintenance, projected a 20% reduction in unplanned downtime, and showed compliance with strict aviation regulations. Approved within one meeting, the project delivered ROI in under 12 months.
